


Landscape Foundation Students Design Competition 2016 – "Landscape: Change is the only constant" is an attempt to provoke and encourage students to explore and expand the idea of the '*impermanence*' in our landscapes. It is an attempt to trigger their thoughts to look at landscapes through the lens of temporality, recognizing their inherent relation with natural processes, hence time, which is always in a transient mode.

Landscape – Change is the only constant

Landscape design is a spatial design discipline which is close to nature. Landscape is typically a composition of natural elements—land, water and vegetation—through which an artist or a designer conceptualizes and finally realizes a creative endeavour. Visualized to fulfil various aesthetic and functional uses, they provide a framework to a site within which the designer works. Having the natural attributes of a living medium, landscapes are born {or, conceptualized}, they grow, and they decay to be reborn again, following the processes of nature, its rhythms and different moods throughout the year. In the order of nature, they are true reflection of time, changing with each season as well as over the years, decades, and centuries, with a unique, dynamic and real quality which is ever changing and never permanent. Observing the journey of water in rivers, the changing water level in reservoirs, the growth of plants and trees, and evolution and disintegration of rock, earth, and sand over the years is evidence that impermanence is an integral part of the aesthetic experience of a landscape. Landscapes should be viewed with a deep understanding of their temporal dimension which makes the art of landscape design relate to the larger reality of the world that everything in the Universe, governed by the laws of thermodynamics, is in transition.

sheet format



All submissions are to be **SENT BY E-MAIL and NOT AS HARD COPIES** in the following format:

- → No less than ONE {1} A1 size sheet {594 mm x 840 mm, VERTICAL FORMAT} and no more than TWO {2} A1's. Entries are liable to be rejected if not submitted as per the requisite size and orientation.
- \rightarrow A concept note of a maximum of 250 words is to be composed in a box of size A5 {148 mm x 210 mm, VERTICAL} on the TOP RIGHT CORNER of the first sheet.
- → Each sheet shall be numbered sequentially in bottom right-hand corner with a recognizable title of the project. No reference of any kind will be made to the name of the participant{s} or their associated institution{s} / college{s} on any of the sheets {except in the Registration Form}. Failure to follow this direction will automatically disqualify the entry.

You may submit the entry individually,

OR

You may also work in groups for the competition. The number of persons per group is limited to a maximum of THREE. Each participant in a group must individually fulfil eligibility requirements.

Any studio work submitted as an entry must be accompanied by a signed letter in original by the overseeing faculty member confirming the authorship of the work. The letter should also contain the contact details of the faculty member. *Landscape Foundation, India* reserves the right to contact the institution to verify the information provided, if required.

Please note that any sheet / sheets submitted as an entry must not have been published in any print media prior to the competition.

The submission is to be sent as upload transfer and with the link email to be sent to landscapefoundationindia@gmail.com as one SINGLE ZIPPED FILE consisting:

- → All sheets in 300 dpi resolution as ".jpeg" files, each not more than 30 MB (for printing purposes)
- \rightarrow All sheets in 72 dpi resolution as ".jpeg" files (for reference purposes)
- ightarrow Concept note in MS-Word file.
- ightarrow Complete Registration Form and Identity Proofs of all participants
- ightarrow Declaration by Faculty (in case of studio work)



Is registration fee mandatory to participate in the competition? Yes.

Do I need to write you an email while sending my registration fee? Yes. You also need to fill up all the payment details in the Registration Form.

If my entry is disqualified from the competition for some reason, shall my registration fee be refunded?

Once paid, the registration fee shall not be refunded in any circumstances. Therefore please ensure that your entry fulfils all eligibility conditions and reaches us on time.

Can I pay my registration fee before the due date and send the entry by due date? Yes. Both need to be sent before / by 10 October 2016.

If I have registered for the competition by paying the fee but for some reason, I am unable to send my entry, shall my registration fee be refunded? No.

Can I pay the registration fee in person before or on the due date? Yes.

I am a student of Art and Photography. Can I participate in the competition? Students from all spatial design, art and design courses all over India are eligible to participate.

Do I need to take a physical site to explore the theme?

Not necessarily. You can also present the theme as a strong philosophical idea that works in all contexts. Do have a look at the winning entries of our previous years' competitions which are uploaded on our website.

Do I need to be present in the jury? No, it is a closed jury.
